

## Organ specification

During the general overhaul and refurbishment the failing and troublesome tubular pneumatic action has been replaced with an electric digital action and piston capture system.

No tonal changes have been made to the pipework.

The function of one coupler has been changed – annotated in the stop list below.

The visible pipes along the front of the organ are none speaking display pipes.

Three manual draw stop console, radiating and concave pedal board
